Location: The position is remote with frequent in-state travel.

Job responsibilities include:

- In-depth bridge building into cities, towns, and communities across Wisconsin, sharing IRG's mission and goals with new groups
- Listening to and learning the policy needs of different communities and groups
- Developing and hosting listening sessions and community events to connect IRG to new stakeholders
- Organizing community leaders to help solve local problems
- Helping distill kitchen-table issues facing Wisconsinites into education products, amplifying voices through storytelling, and assisting with developing free-market policy solutions
- Working with the communications team to tell stories of community leaders
- Assisting with digital media efforts, including content development, strategy, and campaign execution

- Friendly, outgoing, and an interest in meeting new people
- Can work independently with little supervision
- Highly organized with attention to detail
- Self-motivator and hard-worker

- Background in community organizing and grassroots mobilization is a plus
